- some of Marburg's houses can be reached only through a skylight?

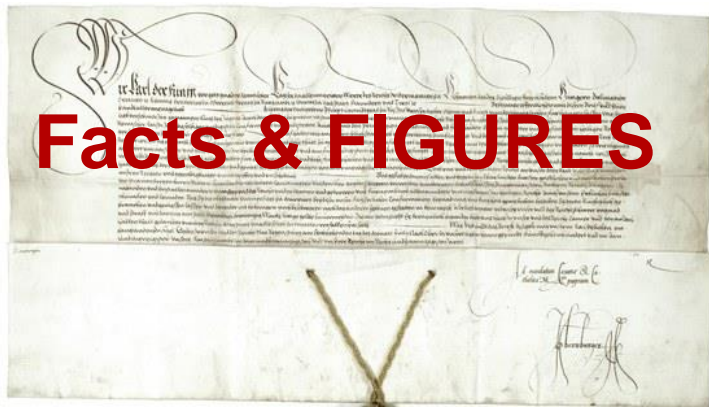

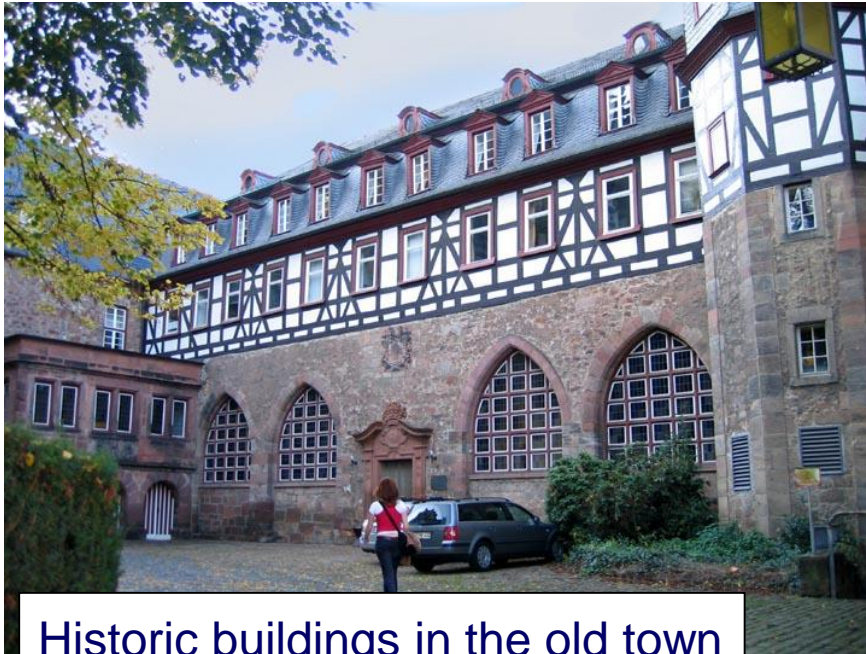

Spring/Summer:

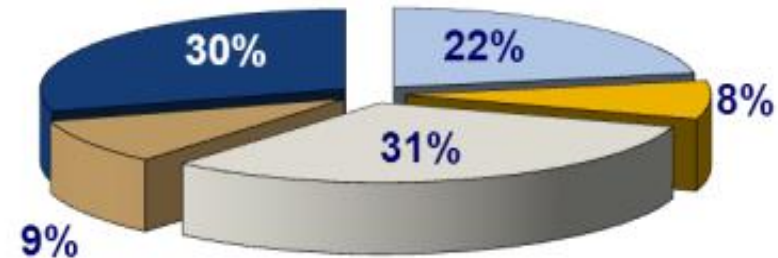
