

While I find that only a specific personality type is suited for presentations, in this project, everybody had the chance to create something in a context they felt comfortable in. I know many students that struggle with public speaking and therefore have a hard time with giving presentations, even though their knowledge is up to the task and they have many different skills that they would not typically be able to apply in a presentation. Here, everybody had the chance to succeed, especially with the attentive and constructive guidance offered by Ms. Wegner and Dr. Rundnagel.
- I enjoyed the freedom we were given in creating the respective Learning Units. I did not enjoy having to work together with other people.
- I particularly think that not only can we deepen our understand to the knowledge we want to share to others, but also learn how to present it in a more effective way. It's helpful and I really like it.

It would also motivate us, if we had the chance to improve our exam grade at least slightly.
- I greatly appreciate the freedom we were given in choosing the type of media we would like to create. This helped me to combine my hobby with the subject of academic writing and I think it resulted in much greater result than it could have if it was just a standard university assignment. I am proud of my part and hope that it will be helpful to other students.

The group work was pretty difficult sometimes, with some members not participating in the discussion at all and uploading their pieces in the last minutes before the deadline without knowing how ilias works at all, even though they had so many chances to ask either us or the instructors about it during the month. Of course it's a bit bothering that some students worked really hard on their parts while others barely did the minimum. As famous saying goes, "Disappointed, but not surprised".
